

DIVINE BLESSINGS

Divine blessings do not come from human's wisdom and intelligence or an inheritance, but it come from heaven. When God created man, He blessed us with divine blessings. Not only He blessed us but He also bind Himself in a Holy agreement also known as covenant. He give the covenant to His chosen people, to whom God's favor is upon them. Secondly, they are looking for a spiritual leader as their role model, a leader who is honest and transparent. We thus have to take care and prepare the younger generations to be the next Elisah in these end times.

God's blessings are His words that are delivered through the people He has chosen. God's blessing are generational blessings given through generations just like Isaac bless Jacob.
